In view of the averments made in the application and in the interest of justice, the same is allowed as prayed for.

CRM-M No.10722 of 2024

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0317 dated 27.09.2023 under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120B, 34 of the IPC (Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sector 6, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar. This is the second petition filed by the petitioner.

2. At the outset, a pointed query has been put to the learned counsel for the petitioner to satisfy this Court as to what was the material change in circumstances after the previous petition seeking

similar relief had been dismissed as withdrawn on 11.01.2024 in the following terms:

*“After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to extend the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner, learned counsel has made a prayer for withdrawal of the instant petition.
Dismissed as withdrawn.”*

3. Learned counsel has miserably failed to bring to the notice of this Court any such material change in circumstances other than his assertion that the petitioner is a patient of carcinoma. On further query put to the learned counsel as to when was the petitioner diagnosed with cancer, he has fairly stated that it was few months prior to the withdrawal of the previous petition. Further, he has reiterated the same submissions which were made when the previous petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. was moved before this Court and subsequently withdrawn.

4. In the circumstances, no ground is made out to entertain the prayer of the petitioner for extending her the extraordinary concession of anticipatory bail. The petition stands dismissed.
