1. Learned counsel for the respondents relies upon an office order dated 06.12.2024, whereby, the petitioner has been found entitled for regularization to the post of Sharmik (Group-D) w.e.f. 01.10.2003 in the pay scale of Rs.2550-55-26600-EB-60-3200 plus usual allowances as admissible under the policy dated 01.10.2003.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Alok Sheokand, Assistant o/o DFO Kaithal, submits that the monetary benefits shall be released in favour of the petitioner within a period of 04 weeks from today.

2. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the present petition.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not

pressed. Rule stands discharged.

4. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
