The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the impugned charge-sheet dated 25.09.2023 (Annexure P-2) and impugned letter/order dated 15.01.2024 (Annexure P-4), instituting departmental enquiry and appointing the Enquiry Officer and Presenting Officer.
