1 Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the petitioner is working as Transport Inspector and has been transferred from Charkhi Dadri within a period of 8 months to Kaithal (Annexure P-4), which is totally violative of transfer policy of department dated 01.06.2022 (Annexure P-5). Learned counsel submits that the petitioner had given 3 stations as an option for transfer whereas, the respondents were required to offer 12 stations for option hence, the transfer of the petitioner has been effected without adhering to the transfer policy of the department (Annexure P-5). Learned counsel for the petitioner lastly argued that the post at Narnaul is still lying vacant and the petitioner can be accommodated there in case, the petitioner has to be transferred from the present place of posting at Narnaul or any other place near Rewari.

2 Notice of motion.

3 Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4 Learned counsel for the respondents submits that whatever the options were filled by the petitioner for the transfer, the same were taken into consideration and appropriate order was passed. Hence, no grievance can be raised by the petitioner qua the order of transfer dated 20.02.2024, Annexure P-4.

5 Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case the post at Narnaul is still lying vacant and the petitioner is interested, he can file appropriate representation for the consideration to the authorities concerned and in case, the authorities finds it feasible, appropriate order on the said request will be passed.

6 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to official respondent for posting him at Narnaul or any nearby vacant station.
