1. By this common order, a bunch of 9 petitions is hereby disposed of since issues involved and prayer sought in the captioned petitions are common. With the consent of parties and for the sake of brevity, facts are borrowed from CWP-4440-2023.
2. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 14.02.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Deputy Labour Commissioner and Appellate Authority, under the Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972.
