DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners are stated to be residing in live-in-relationship. They allege that they are being threatened by the private respondent Nos.4 to 7 and so, have prayed this Court to issue appropriate writ to direct respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty.

2. The perusal of the petition would reveal that petitioner No.1 is already married with respondent No.4 Sahil Kumar about 03 years ago and from that wedlock even a child was born. That marriage still subsists, though they have alleged strained relationship.

3. Petitioners also contend that respondent Nos.4 to 7 have lodged a false complaint against them. Since respondent No.4 is a husband of petitioner No.1, therefore, it cannot be stated that by lodging the complaint against the petitioner, the petitioners are being threatened.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has failed to convince this

Court as to how the petitioners feel threatened to their life and liberty. The present petition appears to have been filed to get the seal of this Court on the apparent illicit relationship of the petitioners. Simply because respondent No.4 is trying to exercise his right, this Court does not find any ground so as to issue any writ.

5. Dismissed.
