Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only the benefit of the grant of one increment under Rule 4.4 of the Punjab Civil Services Rules, Chapter-IV (Volume-I), has not been extended to the petitioner hence, liberty be granted to the petitioner to approach the respondents by way of

appropriate representation and the respondents be directed to decide the same expeditiously so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice as the petitioner is a retired employee.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioners, in the concerned office, the same will be examined in light of the rules governing the service and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
