Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.0586 dated 15.12.2023 registered under Sections 323, 34, 506 IPC (Sections 325, 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.

2. The allegations in nutshell are that on 14.12.2023, complainant-Parveen Sudan was attacked by all the accused including the present petitioner and they caused injuries to him. As per FIR, at the time of the occurrence, the petitioner was armed with wooden *danda* and he gave its blow on the right arm of the complainant.
3. On the last date of hearing, State counsel apprised the Court that the injury attributed to the petitioner was found to be simple in nature caused with blunt weapon. It being so, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join investigation with the police.

4. Today, counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that

pursuant to the aforesaid interim order, the petitioner joined investigation with the police.

5. State counsel on instructions from SI Vijay Kumar has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 28.2.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
