1. This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondents to permit the petitioners to appear in the exams of 1st year course of General Nursing and Midwifery, Diploma Course scheduled to be commencing on 26.02.2024, which date has already elapsed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners wish to agitate other issues and has thus prayed that the present writ petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, however, liberty be granted to the petitioners to file a fresh petition raising the said issues.
3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, with the aforesaid liberty.
4. It is made clear that in case any such petition is filed by the petitioners, the same would be considered independently, in accordance with law.
