The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.407 dated 24.11.2023 registered under Sections 148, 149, 285, 323, 336, 506 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act registered at P.S. Chhapar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 28.02.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Rajesh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police-II, Yamuna Nagar in court today, which is taken on record and on instructions from submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders

dated 28.02.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

The Counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, interim order dated 28.02.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
