Learned counsel for the petitioner pleads no instructions.

2. The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the petitioner for promotion to the post of Lecturer in Political Science (School Cadre) from the day he was given Master's scale.

3. Learned State counsel has referred to the written statement to contend that as per service Rules, there are two feeder channels for promotion to the post of Lecturer, one is Master, and other is Classical and Vernacular (C&V) teacher. The petitioner was appointed as Junior Basic Training (JBT) teacher on 01.11.1986, and was given Master's scale while working as such. There is no channel of promotion to the post of Lecturer (School Cadre) from that of JBT teacher. Accordingly, he could not have been promoted to the post of Lecturer merely on the ground that he had been given the Master's scale. He further stated that the petitioner was promoted as S.S. Master on 04.04.1992, and would be considered for promotion as per his seniority.

4. These facts have not been disputed by the petitioner by filing any counter affidavit.
5. In view thereof, there is no merit in the petition stands and it dismissed.
6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall stand(s) disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
