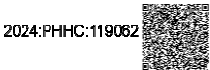

1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the orders dated 29.05.2002 (Annexure P-17) and order dated 28.06.2002 (Annexure P-20) and for directing the respondents to consider the petitioner for substantively promoting him to the post of Senior Auditor. Further prayer has been made to grant the petitioner the pay scale of Senior Auditor from the date he was working as Senior Auditor vide order Annexure P-7 along with interest at the rate 18% per annum from the due date till the actual payment.
2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 29.05.2024, learned counsel for the petitioner sought adjournment to get instructions from the petitioner as to whether any cause still survives or not. Learned counsel submits that despite his best efforts he is not able to get further instructions.



3. In view of the above, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to get the petition revived in case any cause still survives.
