SANJIV BERRY. J. (Oral)

1. After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to deposit the penalty of Rs.50,000/- imposed by learned trial Court and prays that the property of the petitioner may be released from attachment. With aforesaid liberty, learned counsel seeks withdrawal of the present petition.
2. In view of the statement, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to deposit the penalty of Rs.50,000/- as has already been imposed by learned trial Court in accordance with law and move an application for releasing of the property from attachment in accordance with law.
3. It is made clear that if the petitioner deposits the penalty and moves such application, the same be dealt with by the trial Court in accordance with law.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
