1. On 29.11.2023, a Coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased

2. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that inspite of

4. Learned counsel for the appellant prays that the present appeal may be dismissed for non-prosecution at this stage but liberty may be granted to the appellant or her legal representatives to revive the appeal, in case, any cause of action survives.
5. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution with the aforesaid liberty.
