The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. praying for necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for conducting fresh and fair investigation in FIR No.51 dated 11.10.2023 registered at Police Station Cyber Crime Nuh, District Nuh under Sections 406/419/420 of IPC (Annexure P-1) and to further handover the investigation to a senior ranked police official not below the Rank of IPS outside the territorial jurisdiction of District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner is the victim of cyber fraud. The Investigating Agency is sitting over the investigation as colluding with the accused and failed to perform their statutory duty and in this regard, a representation dated 13.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) has been moved.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Bhajan Lal, submits that the Investigating Agency conducting the investigation in a fair and free manner and they will take the investigation to logical conclusion.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the record, this Court finds no ground to transfer the investigation of the case to police official of the rank of IPS outside the territorial jurisdiction of District Nuh and, thus, the same stands dismissed.
