1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to absorb her in Clerical Cadre. She is further seeking setting aside of order dated 09.11.2001 (Annexure P-8) whereby she was shifted to Chandigarh in Chief Minister Security Staff, Punjab
2. This Court vide order dated 07.03.2003 stayed the impugned order.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner, on attaining age of superannuation, has retired on 04.12.2023, thus, the present petition has rendered infructuous.
