The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the order dated 21.03.2002 (Annexure P-8) as also the action of the respondent-Corporation in not promoting the petitioner to the post of Senior Deputy General Manager being fully eligible and for a direction to the respondent-Corporation to consider and promote the petitioner to the post of Senior Deputy General Manager w.e.f. the date respondent Nos.2 and 3 have been promoted along with all consequential benefits.

2. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner as well as the respondents on the last date of hearing i.e. 20.08.2024 and notices were ordered to be issued to the petitioner as well as the respondents.

3. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back with the report "retired from service", notice issued to respondent No.1 has been received back duly served and notices issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3 have been received back with the report "retired from service".

4. Since, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
