By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C, the
petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 15.04.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. During the course of hearing on 15.04.2024, following order had been passed: -

“During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over banker’s cheque dated 15.04.2024 amounting to Rs.2,90,000/- favouring

Munim Kumar S/o Mam Chand i.e. the complainant. Copy thereof has been placed on record.

2. The aforesaid cheque has been received by learned counsel for the complainant Munim Kumar and has pleaded no objection in case the petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail.

3. Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the facts and circumstances, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

4. List on 02.05.2024.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions from PSI Sumit Kumar informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 15.04.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 15.04.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.
7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not
be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
