MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J. (Oral)

By filing the instant revision-petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought the indulgence of this Court for issuance of a direction to learned Family Court, Gurugram, to expedite the hearing and decide the petition bearing ***GW No.67 of 2022*** titled as '***Manoj Kumar Megotia Vs. Lakshmi Aggarwal and another***', along-with all the pending interim applications, in a time bound manner, preferably within a period of 06 (six) months, while averring that he is the father of respondent No.2-minor child and is longing to meet his son and the afore-referred petition, as preferred by him for seeking his (son's) custody, is pending since the year 2022.

2. However, at the time of assisting the Court at the preliminary stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has restricted her prayer only to the

issuance of direction to the Family Court to decide the above-said petition and the interim applications, as moved therein, expeditiously.

3. Heard.

Keeping in view the facts that the afore-mentioned petition, as preferred by the petitioner for seeking the custody of respondent No.2, his minor son, is pending adjudication for the last more than 1½ years and the applications as moved by him therein, including the one for grant of the interim custody of his son to him, are also yet to be decided and without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits of the above-referred main petition and the interim applications, the revision-petition in hand is, hereby, disposed of with the direction to the concerned Family Court to expedite the proceedings and to decide the petition as well as the interim applications under reference, in accordance with law, as early as possible.
