This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for direction to the respondents to grant two advance increments to the petitioner from the due date on the basis of recommendations made in his Annual Confidential Reports as has been done in the cases of other similarly situated persons.
2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 11.07.2024 learned counsel for the petitioner sought last opportunity for getting instructions from the petitioner. Learned counsel submits that despite her best efforts, she has not been able to get further instructions from the petitioner.
3. In view of the above, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to get the same revived if any cause still survives.
