1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order (Annexure P-4).
2. Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent has submitted that the present matter pertains to the year 1999 and in all likelihood, the petitioner has retired from service and nothing survives in the matter and thus, the present petition in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.
3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.
5. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall stand disposed of with the abovesaid order.
