The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.27 dated 01.02.2021 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 26 (East), Chandigarh.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 01.03.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
