SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of the order dated 06.10.2023 (Annexure P-4) passed in FIR No.0139 dated 24.07.2019, under Sections 22 and 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana, vide which the petitioner has been summoned through non-bailable warrants.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there was a miscommunication between the petitioner and his counsel due to which the petitioner could not appear on 06.10.2023. He further submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the trial Court.
3. Without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court.
4. In case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and applies for bail, the same shall be considered in accordance with law on that very day itself.

5. However, the aforesaid order/concession to the petitioner shall be subject to payment of Rs.10,000/- as costs to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Clerks Social Welfare Fund Association, Chandigarh and a receipt of the same be produced before the Trial Court and only in that eventuality application of the petitioner seeking bail be considered by the Trial Court.
6. Ordered accordingly.
