1. Petitioners have filed present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, direction or order quashing the orders dated 05.07.1993 and 30.11.1998 (Annexure P-3 and Annexure P-5, respectively) passed by Commissioner, Rohtak, Division, Rohtak and Financial Commissioner, Haryana, Chandigarh, respectively.

2. Vide order dated 22.07.2024, following order was passed:-

“Learned State counsel informs the Court that Mr. R.S. Mittal, Senior Advocate, who was earlier representing the petitioner(s), has expired and Mr. Sudhir Mittal, Advocate was elevated to the Bench of this Court and has since retired.

Accordingly, let fresh notices be served upon the petitioners (in both the cases) for 22.10.2024.



Learned counsel for respondents No.5 to 8 be notified of the date fixed.

Photocopy of this order be placed on the file of connected case.”

2. As per office note, petitioners No.1 to 3 are reported to have died and petitioners No.4 to 7 have been served, but neither anyone has appeared on their behalf nor any application for impleading legal representative has been moved. It appears that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant matter any further.

3. Keeping in view the above, instant writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

4. Since the main case has been decided, pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of accordingly.
