VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. The present appeal has been filed by the plaintiffs, whose suit for permanent injunction was decreed by the trial Court but was dismissed by the appellate Court.
2. Learned counsel for the appellants has submitted that as per his instructions, as of now, there is no apprehension of dispossession of plaintiffs at the hands of the defendants and thus, the present appeal has been rendered infructuous but liberty may be granted to the appellants to revive the appeal in case any cause of action survives.
3. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present appeal is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the appellants to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.
