JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of Award dated 14.10.1997 (Annexure P-3) whereby Labour Court has rejected his claim.
2. The petitioner worked with respondent from January' 1970 to October' 1987. He claims that he was compelled to submit resignation whereas Management is claiming that on account of his illegal act and omissions, he himself offered resignation which was duly accepted.
3. Counsel for the parties submit that they leave it to this Court to determine amount of compensation to rest the litigation.
4. On the asking of Court, Mr. H.S. Bedi, Advocate and Mr. Rahul Sharma-I, Advocate agreed that the matter would be finally settled if respondent No. 2 makes payment of Rs.35,000/- to the petitioner within 6 weeks from today.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to pay Rs.35,000/- to the petitioner within 6 weeks from today, failing which respondent would be liable to pay interest @ 9% per annum.
6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
