By way of present petition, prayer was made by the petitioner to direct respondents No.1 to 5 to protect his life and that of his family members from the hands of respondents No.6 to 11.

Status report has already been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5, para No.8 of which is relevant and the same reads as under:-

“That it has been found during inquiry that the appeal filed by the petitioner – Sarabjit Singh before the Additional Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Rupnagar, has already been dismissed on 14.03.2023 and during the hearing of aforementioned appeal before the Additional Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Rupnagar, the petitioner-Sarabjit Singh has apprehended that he was losing the appeal and he moved the instant representation that he was losing the appeal and he moved the instant representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, and also filed present petition just to put pressure upon the respondent no.6 to 8 in order to restrain them from looking after the case of SGPC before the revenue

authorities. It is further submitted that from thorough inquiry it has been established that the petitioner or any of his family members has no apprehension to his/ their life and liberty and therefore, the present petition is liable to be dismissed.”

In view of the afore-said report filed by respondents No.1 to 5, no direction is required to be issued by this Court.
