Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the order dated 30.11.2023 (Annexure P-18) to the extent of mentioning the designation of the petitioner as Personal Assistant whereas he retired as Private Secretary from the Corporation. Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the respondents to pay all the financial benefits as a consequent of his promotion from the post of Personal Assistant to Private Secretary since 14.01.2021, till his date of superannuation with interest @ 12%.

After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file afresh petition with better particulars, on the same cause of action, particularly by challenging the order dated 28.09.2023, passed by the Principal Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Water Resources.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
