1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 10.09.1999 (Annexure P-1) whereby he was dismissed from service and order dated 15.12.1999 (Annexure P-2) whereby his appeal was dismissed.

2. The petitioner joined Punjab Police as Constable on 01.01.1994. He came to be terminated by impugned order dated 10.09.1999 on the ground that he has submitted forged matriculation certificate. As per matriculation certificate submitted by him, his date of birth is 04.02.1973 whereas his actual date of birth is 04.02.1971. The Respondent after terminating him lodged FIR No. 327 dated 28.10.1999 under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station Civil Line, Patiala against him. He came to be convicted vide judgment dated 30.04.2008 passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patiala. He preferred appeal which came to be dismissed vide judgment dated 21.07.2009 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala. He further preferred CRR-2126 of 2009 before this Court which came to be dismissed vide judgment dated 08.08.2024. The petitioner stands convicted for



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submitting forged matriculation certificate, thus, there is no ground to interfere with orders passed by the Authorities whereby he was terminated from service.

- 3. Dismissed.
- 4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
