1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to promote him as Inspector from the date his juniors have been promoted.
2. The petitioner is working with Punjab Police. He joined Punjab Police on 01.07.1991. He from time to time was promoted. He claims that his juniors have been promoted prior to him though he is having medals in sports.
3. Mr. Gagan Pradeep S. Bal, Advocate submits that grievance of the petitioner, at this stage, would be redressed if respondents are directed to decide his representation (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner.
4. Notice of motion.

Mr. Aman Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and assures the Court that competent authority would look into representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law within 8 weeks from today.

6. In view of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of.
