By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C, petitioner pray for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.194 dated 16.12.2023 registered under Sections 452/324/148/149 IPC (later on added offence under Section 326 IPC) at Police Station Sadar Patti, Tehsil Patti, District Tarn Taran, Punjab.

Allegations are that the petitioner along with co-accused barged into the house of complainant. Petitioner was armed with a gandasi and inflicted blow with gandasi on the right hand of the complainant – Juj Singh, slicing his fingers. As per the MLR, three incised wounds were found on the person of the injured, all caused by sharp edged weapon, attracting Section 326 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated; that he is ready to join the investigation and that the co-accused have already been allowed bail.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, having regard to

the specific role attributed to the petitioner, to have inflicted injuries with gandasi on the complainant, slicing away his fingers. As such, the present petition is dismissed.
