The present petition has been filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India, read with Sections 10 and 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for summoning and punishing the contemnor for wilful disobedience of order dated 14.02.2022, passed by this Court CWP 20384-2021 titled as '*Pradeep Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others*'.

2. Counsel for the respondent submits that pursuant to the previous order, costs of Rs.10,000/- have been paid vide receipt No. 4181 dated 23.05.2024. While relying on the affidavit of Belina (HCS), Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estate, Gurugram, filed in Court today, counsel for the respondent has submitted that the amount has already been deposited with the executing Court from where the petitioner can get the same. The Registry is directed to scan the aforesaid affidavit and place the same on the file, at an appropriate place.

3. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

4. However, if any of the grievances of the petitioner is left unredressed, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
