VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. On 09.01.2024, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had observed that learned counsel for the appellants had sought number of adjournments for impleading the legal representatives of the respondents but no application had been filed and last opportunity was granted.

Learned counsel for the appellants has submitted that inspite of his best efforts, office of counsel for the appellants has not been able to get in touch with the appellants to get instructions as to whether any cause survives in the present appeal and hence, he prays that the present appeal may be disposed of at this stage but liberty may be granted to the appellants to revive the appeal, in case, any cause of action survives.
