2. For the reasons mentioned in the application, which is duly support by an affidavit of the applicant-petitioner, the same is allowed and the date of hearing fixed in the accompanying petition is advanced from 24.07.2024 to today itself. The main petition is taken up on Board for hearing.

CRR-737-2023 (O&M)

1. The present Criminal Revision Petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 29.11.2022, passed in an appeal by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, whereby the order dated 03.12.2021

passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram, granting interim maintenance to the tune of ₹40,000/- per month to respondent No. 1-wife has been enhanced to ₹70,000/- per month.

2. There is no such order which is criminal in nature and keeping in view of the ratio of the decision given by this Bench in CRM-M-58023-2023, titled Gautam Singal vs. Anju Singal, decided on 30.11.2023, the present petition is not maintainable.

3. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to avail remedy, as per law.

4. It is made clear that nothing observed hereinabove or in the previous order (s) passed by this Court will be taken to be an expression on the merits of the case.

5. Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
