Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that unfortunately the petitioner has died during the pendency of the present petition and the present petition is being pursued by his daughter being a legal heir. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that relief which is being prayed as of now is for the release of arrears of pension as well as interest on the arrears of salary, which was paid to the petitioner during the pendency of the present petition,

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case, any representation is received from the daughter of the petitioner, the same will be examined in the light of the fact that whether there is any discrepancy in the release of pensionary benefits to the petitioner and in

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case, it was found that petitioner was entitled for any arrears on account of pension, the same will be released to the daughter of the petitioner otherwise, due reasons for the not granting the same will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed and while passing the speaking order, claim of the petitioner for the grant of interest on the delayed release of pensionary benefits will also be considered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file an appropriate representation with the respondents.

Ordered accordingly.
