VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for restraining the respondents No.3 to 8 from harassing the petitioners, disturbing the working of petitioner No.2 and for directing the respondent No.2 for taking the action as per the application (Annexure P-9).

2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that a complaint has been submitted by respondent No.8 against the petitioners to the Deputy Commissioner, Jalalabad with the allegations of misappropriation of funds and the said complaint has been marked to SDM, Jalalabad, which is being enquired into. It is submitted that no mention of the said complaint has been made in the present petition and the same is complete abuse of the process of the Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view

of the said fact, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail alternative remedy in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
