1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 2-B read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 28.07.2022 passed in CWP-16307-2022.
2. Affidavit of the respondent filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 28.07.2022 passed in CWP-16307-2022 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 15.04.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order 15.04.2024 passed by the respondent/concerned authority.
