The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that the order dated 18.01.2019 vide which the respondents have been discharged by the Learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar under sections 323, 324, 325, 354-A, 427, 504 and 506 of IPC is wrong, unjust and unreasonable and against the facts of the case.
2. This matter pertains to the year 2019. On 19.02.2020, when the matter was listed for hearing, the same was adjourned on the request made by proxy counsel and notice could not be issued.
