1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that keeping in view the policy dated 14.08.2023 (Annexure P/8) issued by the Government of Haryana, the petitioner, who is a widow of Naveen Kumar, who was working in the CRPF and had died while in service, is entitled for the grant of benefit of compassionate appointment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had already submitted her claim with the Government of Haryana for the grant of said benefit by way of representations dated 20.01.2023, 01.04.2023 & 16.10.2023 (Annexures P/5 to P/7 respectively) but no action is being taken by the respondents, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3.

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Ms. Neha Jaggi, Senior Panel Counsel for UOI accepts notice

on behalf of respondent No.4.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case representations dated 20.01.2023, 01.04.2023 & 16.10.2023 (Annexures P/5 to P/7 respectively) have been received from the petitioner and are still pending consideration with the concerned authorities, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case after examining the claim of the petitioner, she is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to her and in case relief being claimed is not found admissible to the petitioner, due reasons will be given in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner as well.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
