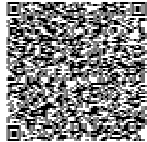

LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondent – Bank not to take forcible physical possession of residential house of petitioners as they are stated to be ready and willing to settle the entire outstanding loan under One Time Settlement policy.
2. Learned counsel for petitioners submits that One Time Settlement has been sanctioned in favour of petitioners, who would abide by terms and conditions thereof.
3. Learned counsel for respondent – Bank affirms and verifies that One Time Settlement for a sum of ₹8.50 lakhs has indeed been sanctioned in favour of petitioner on 20.03.2024.

4. Learned counsel for parties submit that in view thereof, this writ petition is rendered infructuous.
5. This writ petition is disposed of as infructuous without any expression of opinion on the merits of the matter or even its entertainability.
