Present fourth petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.225 dated 14.07.2019, under Sections 302, 307, 201 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860; Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Assaudha, District Jhajjar.
