1. The present petition has been filed under Section 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for summoning and trying the respondents for having committed willful disobedience of the order dated 03.01.2024 passed by the Court of Shri Rajinder Singh Nagpal, Additional Civil Judge, Senior Division Samana in Civil Suit 03/2024 titled as '*Balbir Singh alias Balbir Jain vs Shiv Kumar and others*'.
2. Perusal of the file shows that the order qua which contempt is alleged has been passed by the civil Court; which has every power to get its orders enforced and even to summon the respondents in contempt, if at all, that Court finds the same to be justified in the facts and circumstances of the case. Therefore, this Court does find any ground to pass any direction in the present contempt petition and the same is liable to be dismissed.
3. Ordered accordingly.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other remedy, but in accordance with law.
