The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant the regular pay scale of Rs.1500-2640, which is admissible to the Junior Engineer w.e.f. 21.06.1994 after regularising him formally and to pay the arrears along with interest @ 18% per annum from the date when it became due till its realization.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 03.07.2024, the following order was passed:-

“As per office report, learned counsel for the petitioner could not be informed as no correct detail is available.

Let notice be issued to the petitioner returnable on 30.07.2024.”



As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report that the firm mentioned in the address has been sold and no such person is working there.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 submits that the Barnala Cooperative Cotton Marketing and Spinning Mills Limited, Tapa Mandi, Punjab (respondent No.3) has been wound up and the registration of the said mills stands cancelled.

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner and there are no means with this Court to serve the petitioner, therefore, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
