Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to construct the Street No.616 situated in the Revenue Estate of Village Lawn, Tehsil Narwana, District Jind as resolved/approved in Resolution dated 29.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) after doing proper levelling and drainage of waste/rainy water of Street No.616, 617 and 619 and after preparing proper scheme, plan and estimate, because the construction of Street No.616 has been withheld by respondent No.5 on false and baseless excuse of non-availability of requisite funds, which is contrary to the income and expenditure accounts of Gram Panchayat of Village Lawn relating to year 2018-19 as is evident from cash book summary or in the alternative, the respondents be directed to redress the grievances of the petitioner as urged in the Reminder Legal Notice dated 01.12.2021 (Annexure P-9).

It has been submitted by learned State counsel that this petition was filed praying for constructing Street No.616 which has not been done despite having been passed the Resolution. He further submits that the status report has been filed by the BDPO. He has drawn the attention of this Court to the status report and has submitted that Street No.616 has already been constructed with cemented blocks and the new Gram Panchayat has passed a Resolution dated 10.04.2023 to that effect. He thus, submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner in the petition has already been redressed and thus, nothing remains in the petition for adjudication.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel that the grievance of the petitioner is already redressed, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
