RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 08.08.2023 passed in CWP-11913-2017 and CWP-12836-2018.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Chetan Dev Chawla, presently Chief Engineer, Administration, HPGCL, Panchkula, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 08.08.2023 passed in CWP-11913-2017 and CWP-12836-2018 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 07.05.2024 has been passed. Even the employment has been provided to the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
