ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

On 14.03.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Because of non-filing of the process fee, fresh notices could not be issued to the respondents.

Counsel for the applicant – petitioner is not present.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 28.03.2023.

Counsel for the applicant - petitioner be informed of the date fixed”.

Even though, vide order dated 14.03.2023, the office was directed to inform the counsel for the applicant of the date fixed and as per office report learned counsel was duly informed through e-mail, yet on the adjourned date none chose to appear for the petitioner. Nor the process fee was furnished to ensure service upon the respondents. Accordingly, on 17.08.2023, following order was passed:-

“As per office report, notice could not be issued to respondents as process fee was not filed.

On doing the needful within one week, fresh notice be issued to respondents for 18.01.2024.

Last opportunity is granted.”

The position is not any different even today as the applicant is still unrepresented and as per the office report no process fee was furnished.

That being so, the Court is choice-less but to dismiss the review application for non-prosecution.
