1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to grant temporary release (Parole) to the petitioner.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would restrict his prayer and will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to decide Annexure P-2, which is a letter dated 08.12.2023 from the Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot to the Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka with regard to grant of parole to the petitioner.
3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka to look into the letter dated 08.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with the rules at the earliest.
