In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that they should be released all the arrears of the provident fund and medical allowance along with the interest keeping in view the subsequent Satluj Yamuna Link Project. The respondents have filed the reply that the petitioners were only working on a work-charged basis and there was no provident fund deduced or medical allowance given to a work-charged employee and only a fixed medical allowance is admissible to a regular work-charged employee hence, the petitioners were not granted the benefit which they are claiming as the same is not admissible to them.

The present petition was admitted on 27.08.2002 and approximately 22 years have passed and no one has appeared on behalf of

the petitioners. It can be safely presumed that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the present petition.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed off.
