Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondents No. 4 to 8 to release the detenue namely Sheelu, legally wedded wife of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner has solemnized love marriage with the daughter of private respondents against their wishes on 16.01.2024 and both of them are major. On 25.01.2024, the private respondents approached the petitioner and convened a Panchayat and took away the legally wedded wife of the petitioner with them on the pretext that they would send her after performing the ceremonies and since then the petitioner is not allowed to meet his wife and she has been illegally confined by the private respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vikas Bhardwaj, AAG Haryana, who is present in the Court accepts notice on the asking of the Court and seeks time to file status report.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to produce the detenue before the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate for

the purpose of recording her statement and in case, the detenue deposes to live

with her husband i.e. the petitioner, the detenue be released forthwith to join the company of her husband and respondent No. 3 shall take action in accordance with law.
