The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.
seeking anticipatory bail in FIR mentioned below:-

2. Vide order dated 01.03.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel filed status report dated 18.04.2024. The same is taken on record. He further, on instructions states that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 08.03.2024 and he is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose will be served by detaining him in custody. In view of the said facts but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 01.03.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
